#### WHERE IS LA VERNE?


The City of La Verne is located in the Pomona Valley, 30 miles east of Los Angeles. La Verne has more than 30,000 residents and a well balanced community with a good mix of residential, commercial and industrial features. La Verne is a "close knit" community that is home to many fine institutions and facilities among which include the University of La Verne (founded in 1891), Brackett Airport and fine public and private schools and sits next door to the biggest county fair in the nation, The Los Angeles County Fair. La Verne is one of the most desirable communities in metropolitan Southern California, La Verne is a progressive city that has retained much of its small town charm.

#### ACM CONFERENCE PARKING:

The University of La Verne will be holding its annual Homecoming Football game on Oct. 15. Attendees are asked to park at the Bonita High School parking lot (3102 "D" Street) located between Foothill Blvd. and Bonita Ave. There will be a shuttle for attendees from 8:30 a.m.- 11:30 a.m. and 3 p.m.- 6 p.m.

#### WAVE AWARDS PARKING:

Please park in campus lots. Permit Parking will be lifted for this event. No permit is necessary.



From the northwest (2 options): Foothill Fwy. (I-210) east. Exit at Foothill. Continue east on Foothill to Wheeler Ave. Turn right (south) on Wheeler to Third St. (one block past Bonita Ave.) Turn left (east) on Third. Turn right on C Street. OR

OR
Foothill Fwy. (I-210) east. Exit
at Fruit St., turn right (south).
Fruit will turn into White
Avenue after crossing Foothill
Blvd. Continue south on White
to Third Street. Turn right on
Third (one block past Bonita
Awe) and continue (west) to C
Street, Turn left on C Street.

From the northeast:
West on Foothill Fwy. (P-210)
Exit at Fruit St., turn left
(south). Fruit will turn into
White Avenue after crossing
Foothill Bird. Confluiue south
on White to Third Street. Turn
right on Third (one block past
Bonita Ave.) and continue
(west) to C Street. Turn left on
C Street.

From the east or west:
San Benration Fwy. (1-0) to Fairplax Dr. exit (from east, look for Fairplax Dudley exit). Go north (right from the east, left from the west) on Fairplax to L. A. County Fairgrounds. Turn left (week) and follow Fairplax Dr. along the perimete of the fairgrounds, confirming north on E St. past the traffic signal (Arrow Hwy) to Third St. Turn left (week) on Third and then turn left on O Street.

From the south:
Orange Fwy. (57) north to San
Bernardino Fwy. (1-10). East
on 1-10 to first exit (Faripiex
Dr) and follow same directions
as for "east or west." Afternate
route: 57 to Arrow Highway
exit. Proceed straight through
the traffic light, you are now on
Bonita Avenue. Continue east
on Bonita and turn right at C
Street.
